Hi everyone. I'm so glad you can join me today. This is being recorded the evening of Nov 6, evening of the 1st day of the week, just a day and a half from the USA's Election Day. I really would like to welcome whoever becomes our next President of the USA, but really this message is applicable to all leaders, of all nations, whoever and wherever they are. And to all future leaders.

I pray that somehow Mr. Trump and Mrs. Clinton will hear/read this.

At this point as I record this – just a day before the U.S. election -- the race is neck and neck and nobody can predict with certainty who the next president of the USA will be. So I address this message to BOTH candidates – to Madame Hillary Clinton and to Mr. Donald Trump (and really to all future leaders too). I may refer to you both from time to time as “President Elect” – since I don't know which one. My heart tells me which one will win... but let's see.

I don't want this to be a partisan message, so that is why I'm recording it *before* the election. We've come to the “Super Bowl” of national elections!

TO those of you who are being called now to be Kings and Priests with Christ (Revelation 5:10; 20:4-6) when He returns soon – this message will also apply to you and to me. You see, we also are being called to be leaders of the cities and nations of the world, maybe even within 20 years from now... or even very, very soon (see Matthew 25:34 and Rev. 20:4-6). So what I'll show from God's word for leaders applies to you and me also. IN fact, if you're a father or mother or older brother or even just a little boy or girl and you lead a pet ... all of what I am about to say can apply to so many. And never forget, scripture calls us sojourners on this planet (Hebrews 11:13).

I'll address this message primarily to our next president – but, Believers, please hear *your* name in there as I go along. Frankly, believers, we are all sinners who are trying to reform and I doubt that we'd like the scrutiny that has been placed on the candidates. So – we're not looking down at you, you candidates. We look up to you and hope and pray that you will surprise us all – positively.

One thing that stands out positively: how HARD each of you has worked to ensure your election. I don't know how you kept up! And we Believers also have an election – and we're told to make our own election sure.

By late in the evening of Nov 8 – or certainly by Nov 9 -- You – Mr. or Madame President – will have become the leader of the world's strongest nation. **But please remember, you also have a Leader.** His name is Jesus Christ, or Yeshua the Messiah – the name His mama was told to call him. Savior.

President Elect, after the election is over, remember that about half of the country will be mourning - - no matter who is president. More than half of the population – in polling – has said they dislike either one of you but have to vote for the one they dislike less than the other. That polling statistic is hardly complimentary to either of you candidates frankly. Remember that. Maybe that will help you start humbly. A good place to start.

No matter who wins, the rest of us will have to still go to work, will still have our problems, our taxes to pay, our issues to surmount. Most of us will not be rich or made rich by your election. We do realize God is overall in charge and it is to HIM, that most of us believers will be looking. But if you lead us righteously, we will be so grateful.

Let me also add this: NO leader, EVER, has been perfect, except the Son of God. King David wasn't. Abraham wasn't. Moses wasn't. Nobody was. And yet the Almighty put – or allowed – certain ones to rule and used them to accomplish His purpose for that time. So we need to get that bigger picture. Prime Minister Churchill was the man for the hour when needed – but he himself was often crass, brusque, cigar-smoking and rude. Various generals were the men for their time – but they too had unpopular idiosyncrasies – like General Patton or Gen McArthur or Field Marshall Montgomery.

So here are my points:

**** MANY OF US have been praying for the nation. And for you.**

I've even had Australians and others tell me that they're praying for us over here. And – believers – if you haven't been praying for the nation and our leaders, repent right now of that and start praying for your leaders and showing him/her/them the utmost respect – whether or not you feel they are “good people”. That's the way it is among the children of God.

1 Timothy 2:1-3

“Therefore I exhort first of all that *supplications, prayers, intercessions, **and giving of thanks be made*** for all men, *2 for kings and all who are in authority,* that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and reverence.”

Mr. Trump and Mrs. Clinton –you're not our president yet, and certainly not our king – but the principle is there. We should pray for you. And many of us are. But don't get too big a head from that; many are praying out of anxiety over what you might do to the country - - whichever one you are.

1 Peter 2:17

“Honor all people. Love the brotherhood. Fear God. **Honor the king.**”

Here are some cues from the Bible. And again, all these will be applicable to Believers - who someday will be co-rulers of the world's nations and cities with Christ (Matthew 25:34 and Rev. 20:4-6).

Future President, you have a chance to bring joy or groaning to this nation. It's largely up to you.

Proverbs 29:2

**"When the righteous are in authority, the people rejoice;
But when a wicked man rules, the people groan."**

Christ is going to rule the earth – within a couple decades I suspect. Let's learn from him. Here's how His reign is described- at least in one place, but there are so many scriptures that describe His reign (also see Isaiah 11

Psalms 72:1-4

"Give the king Your judgments, O God,

And Your righteousness to the king's Son.

2 He will judge Your people with righteousness,

And Your poor with justice.

3 The mountains will bring peace to the people,

And the little hills, by righteousness.

4 He will bring justice to the poor of the people;

He will save the children of the needy,

And will break in pieces the oppressor."

Here are some pointers from the word of God, drawing from the lessons of previous leaders or kings of Israel and later, Judah.

1. **ASK THE LIVING GOD to HELP YOU, TO GIVE YOU WISDOM. You both, either one of you, need a lot of help from on High. So would anyone else being given this position.**

One of the early kings of Israel was Solomon (Hebrew Shlomo), the son of David. He started out perfectly. Our Great God appeared to him in a dream shortly after he was anointed as King and YHVH offered him whatever he would ask for. Let's read it

1 Kings 3:5-14

At Gibeon YHVH appeared to Solomon in a dream by night; and God said, "Ask! What shall I give you?"

6 And Solomon said: "You have shown great mercy to Your servant David my father, because he walked before You in truth, in righteousness, and in uprightness of heart with You; You have continued this great kindness for him, and You have given him a son to sit on his throne, as it is this day.

7 Now, YHVH *my God*, You have made Your servant king instead of my father David, but I am a little child; I do not know how to go out or come in. 8 And Your servant is in the midst of Your people whom You have chosen, a great people, too numerous to be numbered or counted. 9 **Therefore give to Your servant an understanding heart to judge Your people, that I may discern between good and evil.** For who is able to judge this great people of Yours?"

10 The speech pleased YHVH, that Solomon had asked this thing. 11 Then God said to him: "Because you have asked this thing, and have not asked long life for yourself,

nor have asked riches for yourself, nor have asked the life of your enemies, but have asked for yourself understanding to discern justice, 12 behold, I have done according to your words; see, I have given you a wise and understanding heart, so that there has not been anyone like you before you, nor shall any like you arise after you. 13 And I have also given you what you have not asked: both riches and honor, so that there shall not be anyone like you among the kings all your days. 14 ***So if you walk in My ways, to keep My statutes and My commandments, as your father David walked, then I will lengthen your days.***"

You who are children of God, be praying also that you will be given love, wisdom and lovingkindness as you lead your family, your work associates, or even your pets. When you are offered a city or 5 cities someday, do the same thing: pray for wisdom to serve those people the way our King would delight in.

President Elect: This great nation – with its \$20 TRILLION of debt, with the growing number of enemies we have, with the issues before us – could become a very weak nation very quickly if God doesn't bless you and our nation. Please don't forget that.

2. **Remember that you too will have to give an accounting someday to YOUR King over you (Romans 14:10).** Someday you will stand before the Judgment Seat of Christ and account for how you led this nation. To whom much is given, much will be expected.
3. **AS YOU GO, SO GOES THE NATION. If you're righteous, and promote righteousness, you will be blessed.** If you promote wickedness – you will have to account to the Judge of us all, face to face someday.

You have the "bully pulpit" of the presidency. When a president ridicules the police as being "stupid" or says there's systemic racism in the police force, or when people calling for the death of cops are lauded – then anarchy reigns supreme because they follow your lead, Mr/Madame Pres.

We can see this all through the history of Israel in the Bible. Good king = God blessed the nation, and the nation tended to follow their king's good example. Evil king – and the nation became more and more corrupt.

But it's up to you, Future President – if you will follow the guidance from the Bible or your own conclusions. But God tells us "There is a way that SEEMS right to a man, but its end is the way of death!" (**Proverbs 14:12**). So don't think YOUR ideas are necessarily right unless they square with God's mind, as revealed in His Word.

4. **BE HUMBLE.** Oh, oh, I think this is going to be hard for either one of you, and especially you, Mr. Trump. Madame Hillary hides her pride a bit better. But both of you – at least try! You must not gloat. You must not deride the loser – but be gracious and humble in your victory (assuming it was legal, fair and you followed the rules). If you're the loser, be gracious in your concession speech.

The first king of Israel was SAUL. When he was first selected as king, he was “little in his own eyes” – he was humble (1 Samuel 15:17). In fact, when they looked for him to crown him king, he was found hiding in all the bags of stuff around. But then he began to let his new found power go to his head, he got “lifted up” in pride – and that led him to all kinds of sin.

“Pride goes before destruction...” **Proverbs 16:18**

“....A haughty heart and a proud hear, Him I will not endure” – **Psalms 101:5**

“A proud look” tops the list of the 7 things God says he hates most. Others on the list include a lying tongue, shedding innocent blood, devising wicked plans, a false witness and one who sows discord among brothers. (Proverbs 6:16-19). Frankly both of you have divided the nation, sown discord, among brethren. I hope you will do your best now – whoever ends up as President Elect – to bring the nation back together, whether you consider the other side deplorable or not.

In fact our maker says PRIDE is one of the worst of the worst things he hates.

5. REMEMBER TO SERVE your people. You are commanded BY your Leader, your LORD and Master, not to “LORD IT OVER” ANYONE.

Jesus tells all who aspire to leadership ---don't lord it over.

Mark 10:42-45

“But Jesus called them to Himself and said to them, “You know that those who are considered rulers over the Gentiles lord it over them and their great ones exercise authority over them. 43 Yet it shall not be so among you; but whoever desires to become great among you shall be your servant. 44 And whoever of you desires to be first shall be slave of all. 45 For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life a ransom for many.”

Serve. Our constitutional government was formed as a government OF the people, by the people and FOR the people. It's not about you, President Elect. It's about those you serve. It's about us. It's certainly NOT about rewarding all your big donors and those who have contributed to your campaigns or Foundations.

You cannot say you are serving girls and women – but support late term abortions that END the life of a *helpless* unborn little girl, for example.

And PLEASE: DON'T think you're serving us by just piling on more national debt that will CRIPPLE our future and our nation! Please live within a budget!

And please: work with Congress. Yes, elections have consequences, but it does nothing good for the nation to have the Executive Branch not working with the Legislative (Congress) Branch or vice-versa.

6. REPENT OF YOUR SINS up to this point. You both have many that have come to light. Yehovah knows ALL the ways you each have fallen short of his Way. You can't bleach-bit your sins away. You can't deny them away. There's only one way: acknowledge your Leader as your Savior and ask that His blood, shed for the remission of sins, be applied to you.

We all have sinned. I certainly have. We do not judge or condemn you. I simply say—God's word calls on everyone to repent of the wrongs we've done, of the rights we should have done, and even for just BEING a sinner. And then we are to move on in his forgiveness and change our course and direction.

REMEMBER NINEVEH (located where current day Mosul is), in the book of Jonah. God was going to obliterate them but told them in advance. They – led by their king – repented, and turned from their evil ways, and God relented. They were spared destruction from on high. (**Jonah 3:5-10**).

Some of you who come to this site feel God's future for the nation and the world is already all mapped out and His will is set. I beg to disagree. The story of Nineveh is just too powerful. When you get the time, go back and read Amos' story too (**See Amos 7:1-6**). Notice how God told him twice to proclaim a curse on the evil nation – a plague of locusts and a devouring fire -- but the prophet pleaded for them – and God relented. TWICE.

Where is there a prophet today pleading for America and Britain, Australia and Canada, and your nations? Where? I know I am no prophet, but I plead for my country. I hope I'm not alone.* Will you join me?

It would be SO great to see you, Madame or Mr. President, repentant and changing from the evils that you have each participated in up until now. Live in the grace of our God. And the nation will follow your righteous example, President Elect. As you go, so will go the nation!

But if you live a life of lies and evil and self-serving – this nation will collapse under the weight of its own sins and God's curses – because the nation will follow your evil example. Mark my word, President Elect. So you have a choice. Choose righteousness. Choose to get close to God.

7. **STUDY HIS WORD EVERY SINGLE DAY** – at the beginning and ending of each of your days, LIVE in the Word. By this I do not mean any book except the Holy Bible.** I do not mean the Koran or writings of Plato or anyone else. Seek Guidance from the Word.

Many of your predecessor presidents were men who studied the Word. Certainly President George Washington and Abraham Lincoln did. Certainly President Reagan did.

8. **STUDY THE RULES GOD GAVE TO THOSE WHO WOULD SOMEDAY BE LEADERS AND KINGS OF ISRAEL**. Let's read it.

Deuteronomy 17:14-20

"When you come to the land which YHVH your God is giving you, and possess it and dwell in it, and say, 'I will set a king over me like all the nations that are around me,' 15 you shall surely set a king over you whom YHVH your God chooses; one from among your brethren you shall set as king over you; you **may not set a foreigner over you, who is not your brother**.

16 But he shall **not multiply horses for himself**, nor cause the people to return to Egypt to multiply horses, for YHVH has said to you, 'You shall not return that way again.' 17 Neither shall he multiply wives for himself, lest his heart turn away; **nor shall he greatly multiply silver and gold for himself.**

18 "Also it shall be, when he sits on the throne of his kingdom, that he shall **write for himself a copy of this law in a book, from the one before the priests, the Levites.** 19 **And it shall be with him, and he shall read it all the days of his life, that he may learn to fear YHVH his God and be careful to observe all the words of this law and these statutes,**

20 that his heart may not be lifted above his brethren, that he may not turn aside from the commandment to the right hand or to the left, and that he may prolong his days in his kingdom, he and his children in the midst of Israel.

- **Don't rely on military might (multiplying horses) to keep America strong and safe – but rely on God.** You certainly can have a modern army, but your faith must be in God. TRUST IN GOD. King Hezekiah and King Jehoshaphat were great examples of this. As was King David. They had a military – but their trust was in God.
- **Don't use your position to become more wealthy.** Are you listening, Hillary? This applies to you too, Donald. You are NOT to be self-serving or allow any bribery in your administration.
- **Have your own copy of the Torah – really God's word** – that you read every day. You are not to turn aside from it.
- **Remember you are the servant of the people** – and not the other way around. BECOME humble. I cannot say “stay humble” – as each of you have proven this is problem already. Remember the White House is the People's House. It's OUR house and we let you stay there for 4 years at a time.
- It would be prudent to take from this that God wants you in fact to “Drain the swamp” that is our national government. To us out here outside “the Beltway”— Washington DC seems to be a sewer of corruption, bribery and evils of all kinds. It's time to clean it up. Get rid of corruption in Washington DC and there's so much of it. I believe the “lobbyists” border on being agents of bribery.

Mr. Trump, you have promised to “drain the swamp” if you're elected. Don't let that just be something to win votes before the election. We hope – if you win – you really do drain the swamp that is DC. But start with your own life first. Respectfully sir, please clean up your own mouth and show more respect for all people. Remember what we read earlier – “HONOR ALL”.

If you ask God, He can give either/both of you a new heart and you can become an entirely different kind of person over time – if you seek Him and submit to Him. What a BLESSING you could be to the whole nation and to the world – if you would ask God to change you to be more like Him. Amen.

9. LET THERE BE ONE LAW – FOR EVERYONE – including you. You are NOT above the law. BOTH of you have acted at times as if they feel you could flout the law.

You-- Mr. or Madame President – should not feel you're above the law either. What applies to us should apply to you!

If either of you break the law, you should have to account for that and stand before a jury of your peers – like the rest of the country has to.

In ancient Israel, our God commanded there is but one law. Nobody was to be above the Law. I hope you are both listening. Laws apply to you too. You can't break federal laws and think somehow you are exempted. You're not. There was to be one law for the citizens and the same law for immigrants or foreigners residing in Israel. I hope you are listening.

Numbers 15:16

"One law and one custom shall be for you and for the stranger who dwells with you."

Leviticus 24:22

"You shall have the same law for the stranger and for one from your own country; for I am the Lord your God."

I asked several people what they would say to Mr. Trump or Mrs. Clinton **if they had a chance. I'll read one letter from a woman in TX. (Audio)**

This message could go on and on and on – but in a word, live by the Word of God. Rule by His power, his word, and his love. Have a heart for the poor, the weak, the elderly and the sick. Work for the common man on the street – not for corrupt lobbyists and others who have become rich in the corruption that is Washington DC. You truly become the champion of "the little guy".

And if you will do these things, I think you COULD go down in history as being one of the greatest presidents ever.

But honestly, as much as we'll be watching you, the one we're really watching for -- the REAL leader we look to -- is the coming King of Kings. We look forward to this verse coming to pass:

Revelation 11:15

Then the seventh angel sounded: And there were loud voices in heaven, saying, "The kingdoms of this world have become the kingdoms of our Lord and of His Christ, and He shall reign forever and ever!"

All the best, you future leader and you brethren who will be future leaders yourselves. Lead now by serving, loving, looking after people – and serving your God – and you WILL hear those precious words from your king:

Matthew 25:34-36

Then the King will say to those on His right hand, 'Come, you blessed of My Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of

the world: 35 for I was hungry and you gave Me food; I was thirsty and you gave Me drink; I was a stranger and you took Me in; 36 I was naked and you clothed Me; I was sick and you visited Me; I was in prison and you came to Me.'

That's the kind of person who will be a ruler with Christ, in His soon-coming kingdom.
